1.	Skin of face, ears, and nose Remarks: Asymmetry, crusting, pigmentation, fissures, growths, change in normal color and tone.
2.	Regional Lymph Node Examination: a. Submental b. Submaxillary c. Anterior cervical

3.	Larynx Hyoid Remarks: Larynx – Mobile, without masses, without pain

II.	Intraoral Examination (Seven Step Systematic Assessment)
	Lips (3 parts – Skin, mucosa, vermilion) a. Vermilion borders Remarks: Color, texture, surface abnormalities

	b. Skin Remarks: Same as skin of face
	c. Labial mucosa also sulcus and frenum Remarks: Color, ulceration, swelling, texture, bidigital palpation up and lower lip –masses; moveable, painful, firm, indurated, soft
2.	Buccal mucosa left and right Commissure → Anterior tonsillar pillar Landmark – Stensen's Ampulla (Parotid Duct Opening) Remarks: Color, texture, masses, ulceration, flow of saliva
3.	Gingiva Start upper right →upper left Lower left → lower right Buccal gingiva Labial gingiva Palatal gingiva Lingual gingiva Landmark – Attached, mucosal Remarks: Color, texture, masses, ulceration, swelling
4.	 Tongue 4 parts – Right and left lateral border, dorsum and ventral. a. Dorsum – Abnormality in mobility or positioning of tongue. Landmarks – Fungiform, filiform papillae. Remarks: Pattern of papillae, swelling ulceration, coating, or variation in size, color, texture, deviation. b. Right and left lateral border. (Use gauze to gently pull tongue out of mouth.) Examine from tip → root of tongue. Landmarks circumvallate, foliate papillae. Lingual tonsil. Remarks: Same as dorsum
	c. Ventral surface- Landmarks - Frenum, varicosity

	Bidigittal palpation – Masses, pain, induration
5.	Floor of mouth Landmarks – Warthon's Curuncle, Warthon's Ducts, (Submandibular salivary glands), Tori Remarks: color, texture, swelling, flow of saliva
6.	Hard Palate Landmarks – Rugae, Incisive papilla Remarks: color, texture, swelling, ulcers, perforations
7.	Oral-Pharynx Landmarks – Anterior and posterior pillars, tonsil, uvula, Oralpharynx, epiglottis. Remarks: swelling, abnormal color, ulceration, deviation
